



E-Learning Overview

The Season 2: Learning from the Land learning modules aim to support you in strengthening your personal connections with, and understanding of, the local Land as a way of allowing yourself to better understand and appreciate local Indigenous knowledge, perspectives, culture, and history.

This season will be more reflective in comparison to Season 1: Foundations of Knowledge, and will provide prompts to get outside and ground your learning in your local place.

This learning is in direct response to the 94 Calls to Action from the Truth and Reconciliation Commission of Canada, and the importance of educating all Canadians in workplaces and classrooms.

We each have a role to play in reconciliation by seeking to understand the truth, recognizing the impact of our shared history, and committing to moving forward with respect and empathy. Taking action towards understanding Indigenous perspectives promotes reconciliation. It creates land-based, justice, health, economic and environmental opportunities and builds partnerships between Indigenous and non-Indigenous peoples. **This is just a first step**, and we encourage all participants to seek further learning opportunities with Indigenous peoples and organizations in your own region.

This course is aligned with anti-racism and diversity and inclusion objectives in the workplace.

It is intended to provide a bridge that facilitates direct learning relationships with Indigenous peoples as a result of this heightened awareness.

We encourage you to continue your learning journey with local First Nations, Métis, and Inuit people and organizations closest to you.

This learning is meant to enhance (*not replace*) local Indigenous knowledge.

In this course learning we will:

- Section 1:
 - Explore and build relationships with the Land;
 - Examine ways of interacting with and learning more about the Land;
 - Discuss teaching and learning from the Land;
 - Learn and share best practices for bringing this knowledge and experience into the classroom or to share with others
- Section 2:
 - Understand the importance of Learning from the Land through stories;
 - Reflect on our relationship with the local Land and recognize the importance of deepening this relationship;
 - Build practices to listen more deeply to the local Land and commit to an ongoing practice of connecting with the local Land
- Section 3:
 - Learn the importance of relationships and partnerships in truth and reconciliation work;
 - Acknowledge and participate in different activities that reflect different approaches to truth and reconciliation work;
 - Connect with the concept of culture camps and the importance of revitalizing Indigenous knowledge;
 - Reflect on the ways in which Indigenous learning can be shared;
 - Research best practices in truth and reconciliation work
